Customized Outdoor Programs

(Grades K – 12)

Customized programs are designed based on specific needs, Sunshine State Standards, or desire of the school. Courses available are outdoor cooking, lessons from Project Wet, Project Wild, Project Learning Tree, or be custom designed. Fee – varies.

Project Wet - Teacher In-Service

(Grades K – 12)

The six-hour Project Wet workshop certifying teachers is available. This nationally recognized program provides 80 lesson plans that are adapted to all age levels! This program can be completed at any location.

Orienteering

(Grades 4 – 12)

Come find out how to make your way through the woods using a map and compass. It really IS easy! Depending on the grade, you'll learn how to read a compass, about direction points, how to read a topographical map, and how to use a compass and topographical map together to find your way. Fee – \$5 per student.

Team Building

(Grades 4 – 12)

We can bring team building fun to your school with portable ropes course elements. Learn to better communicate as a grade or class, work on problem solving skills and build a better team. Fee – \$5 per student.

Field Trip Opportunities

Challenge Course

(Low Ropes Course ✦ Grades 4 – 12)
(High Ropes Course ✦ Grades 6 – 12)

The challenge course consists of a nine component low ropes course, 30' three sided climbing tower and 400' zip-line. The program includes instruction on team building, confidence building and creative problem solving. Offered as a three-hour block, program can be expanded to continue building your team of students. Available at Camp Honi Hanta in Bradenton only. Fee - \$15 per student (minimum of 12 paid participants)



Canoeing and Kayaking

(Grades 2 – 12)

Paddle Safe, Paddle Smart is a new curriculum based on getting kids on the water offered to middle school students. Other grade levels can come out for an introductory paddling lesson at either Camp Caloosa in North Fort Myers or Camp Honi Hanta in Bradenton. This program is expanded beyond fun on the water with Project Wet and Wonders of Wetlands curriculum as we dip net and talk about aquatic systems. Fee - \$12 per student.

Fishing (Grades 2 – 12)

Let's go fishing! We'll learn about catch and release, how to identify fish, and protect the environment while having fun fishing. Offered at Camp Caloosa in North Fort Myers or Camp Honi Hanta in Bradenton. Fee - \$12 per student.

Archery (Grades 4 – 12)

Can you hit the target? Come learn the correct stance, about eye dominance and proper angles. Offered at Camp Caloosa in North Fort Myers or Camp Honi Hanta in Bradenton. Fee - \$12 per student.
