

# My Girl Scout Family Patch

This patch program was designed to encourage family members of Girl Scouts to be more involved in the Girl Scout experience. It offers a unique way for family members to participate and spend quality time with the special girl in their life.



## GUIDELINES:

- ❖ Girls must complete this patch individually with members of her family - not as a troop combined effort.
- ❖ Family members of any Girl Scout Daisy, Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior, or Ambassador can complete the requirements of the patch program. Patch requirements must be completed before bridging to the next level, but can be earned again at the next level.
- ❖ Participating family members may be a parent, grandparent, older sibling, guardian, aunt, uncle, or any other adult whom a girl considers "family."
- ❖ One or more family members may complete the activities.
- ❖ Family members must work with the girl to complete the activities, fill in the form, and return it to the troop leader. The troop leader will work with the girl to verify that requirements have been met.
- ❖ This patch is to be worn on the back of the Girl Scout vest or sash.

## TO ORDER THE PATCH:

Once the requirements are met, the troop leader must fill out the Council Patch Order Form and mail it to the council headquarters (available to download at [www.gsgcf.org](http://www.gsgcf.org) ~ downloads page).
