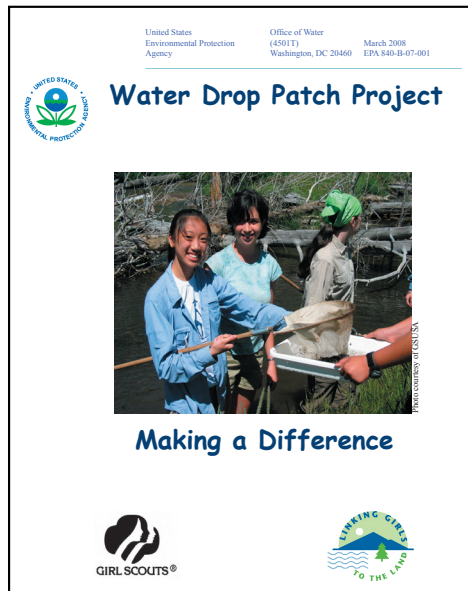


Water Drop Patch Project
