



Gingerbread Festival House Guidelines 2020

House Specifications

- You may use the kit provided to you OR build your own gingerbread house. However, your finished masterpiece **must not exceed our space constraints: 12" wide and 12" deep (this includes the attached base/platform)**. Although there is no height restriction, the house must be stable enough to withstand transportation and stand independently. **Girl Scout staff has the right to refuse any entry that exceeds these space restrictions.** We appreciate your cooperation.
- Be creative! The house **does not need to be edible (yes, you can even use glue)** and you're not limited to the items in your kit—add anything you wish to create your dream house! When building, please consider how you will transport the house to the mall. Build a sturdy house on a sturdy platform. **We recommend you find a platform other than the one provided in your kit, as it is fairly flimsy.**
- Completed houses **MUST** be delivered to the former Stein Mart location in the West District of University Town Center (119 N Cattlemen Road, Sarasota, Florida 34243, next to Old Navy) on December 9 or 10 between 2:00 p.m.–7:00 p.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS CAN BE MADE.**
