Girls thrive in an all-girl environment, based on their developmental needs and meet goals to discover who they are, connect with others, and take action by making their community and world a better place. The Girl Scout Leadership Experience is focused in the areas of: healthy living, the environment, STEM (science, technology, engineering and math), financial empowerment/business literacy, and the arts. Girls and volunteers join Girl Scouting through a variety of pathways: troop, series, event, virtual, camp/environmental leadership, and travel. Professional staff identify, recruit, select, prepare, supervise, recognize and retain adult volunteers who deliver the program with and for girls. Staff ensure that all girls have access to the program through a variety of marketing, educational and outreach efforts.
