- _____ Technology use at cookie booths should be limited to calculators and card processing. Girls and chaperones should not make phone calls or play games for the duration of the cookie booth.
- _____ Girls must be directly involved in the sale.
- _____ Guardians cannot sell cookies on a girl's behalf.
- _____ GSGCF and GSUSA social media policies must be followed.
