

SELBY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Application Opens:

January 1, 2024

What is it?

- Each year, the Selby Foundation selects 40 local students to receive a renewable scholarship, as well as professional development/networking opportunities.
- Awards vary depending on need. The average award is approx. \$4,000/year, but may be as high as \$7,000/year.
- Selected students must maintain a 3.0 GPA to renew award in subsequent years.

Am I eligible?

- You must be a graduating high school senior from a school in Charlotte, DeSoto, Manatee, or Sarasota County.
- You must have "Exceptional Financial Need" and be Pell Eligible, as determined by the 2024-25 FAFSA (or provide alternative documentation to demonstrate financial need if you are unable to complete FAFSA due to immigration status).
- You must have at least a 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA.
- You must plan to attend an accredited college or university to complete a bachelor's (4-year) degree. Students attending state colleges are eligible.
